

Ground Rules for Kibbutz Gezer Baseball Field for the Junior, Cadet and Juvenile League

KGGR01.08

- (a) The head coaches in conjunction with the umpire are responsible for ensuring in Juvenile League games that the location of the on-deck position will not expose the on-deck batter to possible injury. See Juvenile League Rule 12.01.08.
- (b) In Junior and Cadet League games, the on-deck batter should be aware of the danger of being hit by a foul ball.

KGGR02.01

- (a) These Ground Rules only apply to Juvenile League games when played on the main field used by Junior and Cadet League. (They do <u>not</u> apply to any games being played between the temporary and permanent fence.)
- (b) The bases and the pitcher's plate are to be placed at the distances in IAB Rule 12.01.04 and IAB Rule 12.01.07 for Juvenile League play, in IAB Rule 13.02.01 (b) and IAB Rule 13.02.05 (b) for Cadet League play, and in IAB Rule 13.02.01 (a) and IAB Rule 13.02.04 (a) for Junior League play.
- (c) Base coaches and umpires are reminded that while there may not be chalked base coaches' boxes and the boxes are not be laid out as prescribed, Official Rule 6.01 (b) and Little League Playing Rule 7.11 requires any member of the offensive team to "vacate a space needed by a fielder who is attempting to field a batted or thrown ball." (For this interference, depending on who the play is being made, the batter or runner is out and the ball is dead; no runners may advance.)

KGGR04.11

The dugouts at Kibbutz Gezer Baseball Field are both on the third base side of the field. Defensive coaches will remain in their dugout unless they request time and it is granted by the umpire. (This rescinds the Junior, Cadet and Juvenile League privilege under Rule 12.01.23, Defensive Coach, and Rule 13.04.11, Defensive Coach, for a defensive coach to be on the field next to the dugout.)

KGGR05.05

A batter who hits a fair fly ball over the portable fence will be awarded a home run under Official Rule 5.05 (a) (5) in Junior and Cadet League play.

KGGR05.12

If a fielder catches and then carries a live batted or thrown ball through a *gate*, the ball is dead and all runners will be awarded one base.
